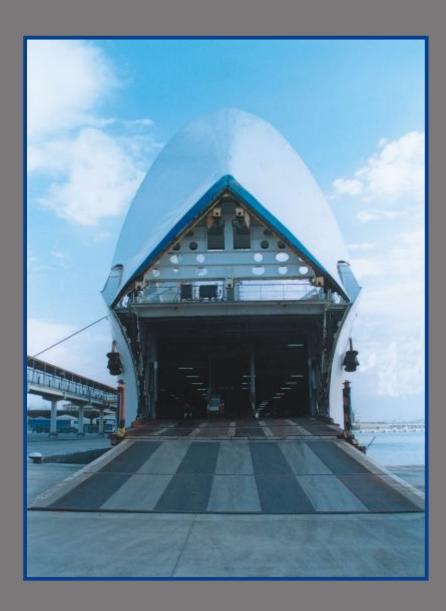

The wide Reference List shows customers of different countries, from highly demanding International operators, to domestic shipowners who handle services between the Spanish mainland and the islands and territories outside the Iberian Peninsula. Customers especially appreciate **SP**'s ability to carry out conversions at a record time, due to the quick-response capacity of their light structure.

Full use of modern computer technology is made, both for planning and logistic purposes, and for detailed calculation of the structural and cynematical parameters of the equipment.

The structure of **SP** has the typical features of any industrial company, where the control of the processes is kept in-house (by the Commercial, Technical, Procurement and Production Departments), while the products are manufactured and installed by outside subcontractors, according to **SP** drawings, technical data and quality standards, and under constant **SP** engineers supervision.

ISO 9001 Standard has been awarded to **SP** by Bureau Veritas.

RO-RO EQUIPMENT

SP is deeply involved in the market of the Ro-Ro vessels, with its special characteristics of detailed design and accurate fabrication and installation.

Large pieces of equipment, which must combine integrity with flexibility, are analysed by means of computer programs. This allows the practical behaviour of the structures when loaded, to be seen.

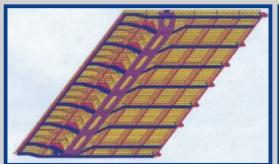
SP is licensed by Lloyd's Register of Shipping (client serial number 2545) for the ShipRight SDA FEM program, and makes wide use of its powerful tools of analysis.

Again, the pre-contract work to define the interface between ship and equipment is of the utmost importance. SP technical staff contribution to the commercial discussions is considered one of the main assets of the company.

SP experience includes all types of equipment, such as:

REPAIR & CONVERSIONS

The SP department which looks after other activities apart from newbuildings (repair, conversions, spare parts, inspections, etc) has been given an important technical content.
